Be kind and considerate.

Please be respectful of other visitors, staff, and volunteers.

Engage in considerate activity.

Please experience our exhibits and spaces in a safe and courteous way so that all visitors can enjoy them.

Stay together and have fun.

The Pavek Museum is a unique place for people of all ages and backgrounds to learn and have fun together. When visiting with young children, please stay with them at all times.

The Pavek Museum requires all visitors adhere to the following policies:

- Wear appropriate attire, including shirts, bottoms, and shoes at all times.
- Treat all visitors, staff, and volunteers with respect.
- Refrain from harassing, intimidating, or disrupting visitors, staff, or volunteers.
- Avoid intentionally obstructing public accessways or preventing Museum activities.
- Do not touch any artifacts or exhibits that are not part of the interactive Nipper Circuit.
- Refrain from using offensive, abusive, threatening, profane, or obscene language.
- Do not engage in abusive, threatening, or violent behavior.
- Do not bring weapons of any kind onto Museum premises.
- Do not possess or use alcohol, drugs, or illegal substances on Museum premises.
- Smoking, vaping, or using cannabis is prohibited anywhere on Museum premises.
- Follow visitor policies or directions of Museum staff.

The Pavek Museum reserves the right to refuse admission, revoke membership, or remove any person who violates this Code of Conduct. Refusal to follow visitor policies or the directions of Pavek Museum staff will result in being asked to leave or trespassed from Museum property.
